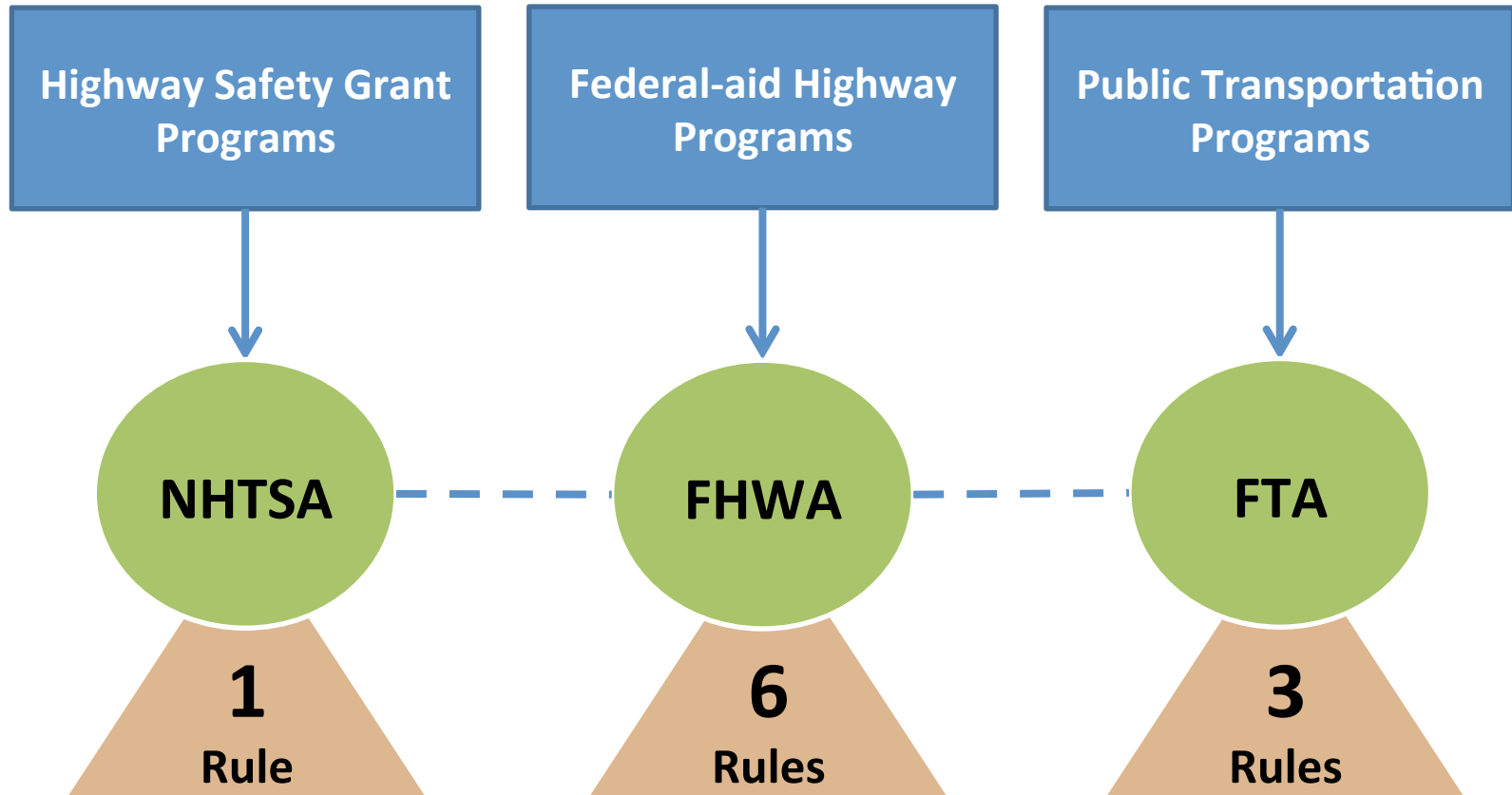
## ***USDOT Performance Measure Areas***

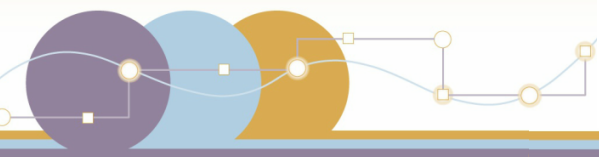

## *Safety Performance Final Rule*

- 5 Measures (5 year rolling average)
  - Fatalities
  - Serious Injuries
  - Non-motorized safety
- Annual State and MPO targets
- One common definition for serious injuries
- Annual reporting on performance
- Annual assessment of progress
