"(e) LIMITATION ON NEW CAPACITY.—

(1) IN GENERAL.—Except as provided in para-
graph (2), the maximum amount that a State may
obligate under this section for projects under sub-
paragraphs (G) and (P) of subsection (d)(2) and
that is attributable to the portion of the cost of any
project undertaken to expand the capacity of eligible
facilities on the National Highway System, in a case
in which the new capacity consists of 1 or more new
travel lanes that are not high-occupancy vehicle
lanes, shall not, in total, exceed 40 percent of the
combined apportionments of a State under section
104(b)(1) for the most recent 3 consecutive years.
